Science Saturday: Earth Day Celebration**

Canton, Ohio... The McKinley Presidential Library & Museum will present Science Saturday: Earth Day Celebration on April 17 from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM or 1:00 to 3:00 PM.

Earth Day is an annual event celebrated around the world on April 22 to demonstrate support for environmental protection. First celebrated in 1970, it now includes events coordinated globally by the Earth Day Network in more than 193 countries.

For Science Saturday, there will be activities, crafts, and informational booths on recycling, clean water, clean soil, composting, pollinators, and nature conservation. The activities will be held in the auditorium. Social distancing will be enforced. Face masks must be worn properly over the mouth and nose for the entire length of your visit.

Science Saturday workshops are included with paid admission to the Museum.
